RULES OF PLAY

All golfers will drive from the tee. A team captain then selects the best drive and each golfer plays the next shot from the location of the best drive. All golfers may set up the second shot by placing it within one club-length, on the same type of surface, no closer to the pin. Thereafter, each golfer plays his/her ball in until the hole is completed. After the drive, play shall be in accordance with USGA rules and each player should mark down his/her score. Final scores will be calculated using the handicap system to produce a net score for the team. The score for threesomes will be adjusted by using a weighted average.

Golfers may only participate in the designated contests if a pass is purchased prior to or upon check-in.

Scorecards are to be turned in at the scoring area upon completion of play.

Scoring will be based on handicaps and the winners will be announced during the Awards Ceremony.

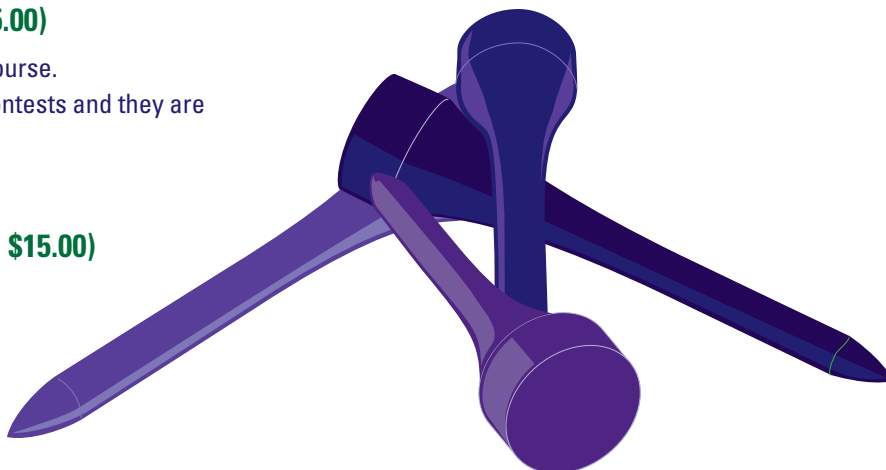
